"CALABASH ELKS DONATE TO 'SGT Eugene Ashley Memorial Center' "

~ Helping Homeless Veterans at SGT Eugene Ashley Memorial Center ~

The Veteran's Affairs Committee (VAC) of the Calabash Elks Lodge ~ 2679 recently donated \$6,000 to the SGT Eugene Ashley Memorial Center under the Good Shepherd Center located in Wilmington, NC. The donation was made possible by a combined Beacon and Spotlight Grant from the Elks National Foundation. The SGT Ashley Center provides transitional bridge residence and recovery programs for homeless veterans. The Center will use these funds for their food pantry, facility maintenance, and support and assistance for the resident veterans. This brings VAC donations to the SGT Ashley Center to almost \$16,000 since 2017.

The Sgt. Eugene Ashley Memorial Center provides short-term transitional "Bridge Housing" for up to 23 homeless Veterans. The Ashley Center was established to provide homeless Veterans with a safe place to live, grow, and become empowered as they make the transition to permanent housing. Since its inception in 2001, the Ashley Center program has succeeded in returning 92% of participating Veterans to permanent housing.
